On the 'Hotels' page of the website there are details of Canterbury Cathedral Lodge, the Hampton by Hilton and other accommodation in the city.

On the 'Trains and Parking' web-page we have shown details of the Lions' Shuttle Bus that will operate between Canterbury West Station and the Convention venue.

Also details of the City's Park & Ride buses, other parking available and photo directions to the Lodge.

Parking at The Lodge in the Cathedral Precincts is severely restricted - but a drop-off is permitted. Virtual Parking Tickets may then be purchased from The Lodge Reception covering 9 city car parks. These are £13.50 for a 24hr period.
