Our new District Governor Steve invites you to our South East District Convention being held over the weekend of 14<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> February next year at Canterbury.

Indeed we will be inside the grounds of the majestic Cathedral that was founded in 597 AD and re-built in the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> centuries.



Convention will be held in The Cathedral Lodge, a modern purpose-built meetings and conference centre.

DG Steve's theme is "Having a Voice" - and this is YOUR Convention where you can have your voice – and share time with fellow Lions from this and other countries.

Convention is our District's AGM where you can take part in the business, help influence decisions on our future and listen to specially invited speakers.

There will be a distinguished Lions International Guest joining us plus friends from our twinned Districts in France and Germany.

I am sure Lions from other Districts and Countries will also be with us celebrating our 54<sup>th</sup> Convention.

Your Convention Committee is currently working hard behind the scenes planning each day including social events for you to enjoy over the Convention weekend.

The Friday is, of course, a special day as it will be Valentine's Day, so naturally the evening party night will have a "Love" theme and will be coupled with a 70-80s disco.

So it is going to be "Love the 80's School Disco" – and there will be an 80's themed menu to choose from !





Saturday evening will be our traditional end-of-Convention, black tie, Banquet and Ball – and you will be able to choose from 'The Archbishop's Menu' !

We are to be entertained by a high quality six piece band named "Plastic Orange".

So please do put these dates in your diary and perhaps you consider making it into a longer break in the lovely city of Canterbury and the surrounding Kent countryside.

There is a variety of accommodation available to suit all budgets.



At The Lodge itself there are a limited number of rooms available, from £150 per room per night (£140 single) B & B, including a mini-flat! (2 bedrooms, kitchen and shared bathroom).

We have also negotiated a Lions bed and breakfast rate of  $\pounds$ 95 per room per night at the nearby "Hampton by Hilton". This hotel is a 10 minute walk away from Convention – a modern hotel but in the old part of the city.

There are also other hotels, including a Premier Inn and a Travelodge, just outside the city walls, but close by.
