On the 'Hotels' page there are details of Canterbury Cathedral Lodge, the Hampton by Hilton and other accommodation.

At the time of writing, The Lodge has 1 double room and 3 singles available – call Chloe on 01227–866204 to book.

On the 'Trains and Parking' page we have shown details of the Lions' Shuttle Bus that will operate between Canterbury West Station and the Convention venue.

Also details of the City's Park & Ride buses, other parking available and photo directions to the Lodge.

Parking at The Lodge is severely restricted but a drop-off is permitted. Parking vouchers may be purchased from The Lodge for city car parks.

The web-site also has pages to register Club Delegates and Alternates and to read Nominations for Office and the Resolutions submitted.

On the 'Meal Booking' page you can book for the social occasions, Cabinet lunch, the Partners' Outing, Saturday sandwich lunch and order Convention Pins (ignore the Coupon Code message at the top of the form).
